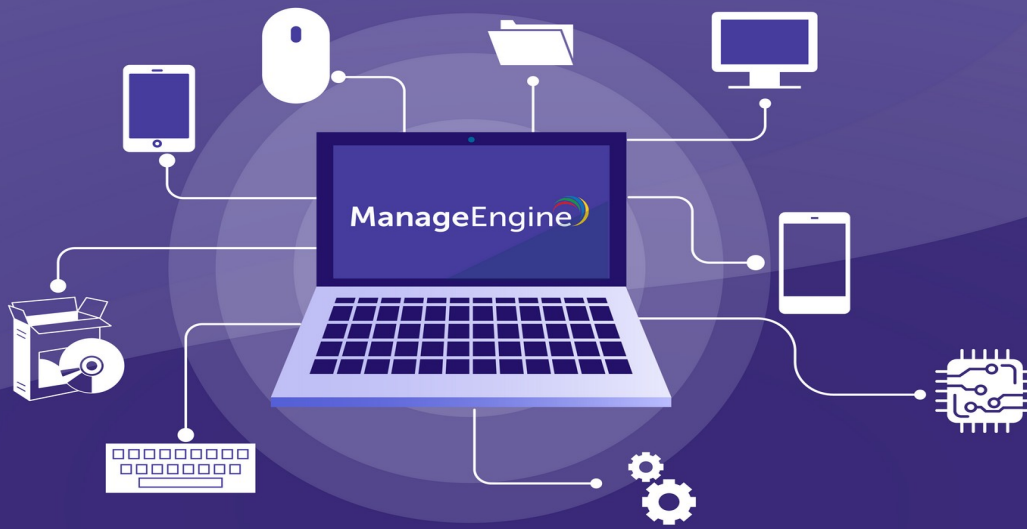

SOFTWARE DEVELOPER

As a software developer, you develop and implement software - from individual modules to complete applications. In coordination with the users in the various departments, you program solutions that are tailored to the respective needs and requirements. In doing so, you always keep an eye on the economic framework conditions and ensure that they are respected.

BUSINESS ANALYST

As a business analyst, you examine business processes and deal with requirements management. This means that you identify, analyze, prioritize and formulate requirements for processes and IT systems. In doing so, you not only keep an eye on existing problems, but also on new opportunities. You coordinate the feasibility with the IT department and at the same time look for cost-effective product solutions that fit in with the company's strategy. Until implementation, you ensure a good interaction between all parties involved.

IT CONSULTANT

As an IT consultant, you advise companies on IT projects. For example, you support the implementation of a cloud infrastructure or the introduction and maintenance of IT systems. You accompany projects from planning to implementation. Your goal: to improve applications and processes and thus make IT-supported workflows more efficient.
