The Executive MBA can be started twice a year, in the summer and winter semester and consists of 11 modules (9 compulsory modules and two of the four elective modules). It includes a personal and leadership development program. The program consists of 56 days of classroom teaching + approximately 11 days of individual learning.

In the course of the program, participants gain an overview of entrepreneurial processes. In addition to professors from the UUT School of Management, experts and top executives from numerous companies and organizations complement the interdisciplinary and intercultural learning. In this way, participants benefit from the research strength of the participating universities and the close practical relevance provided by the partners involved. In the personnel and leadership development program, participants work in small groups or individually on their personal leadership behavior and continuously develop themselves in an interactive exchange with our experts. The aim is to prepare them for extensive leadership tasks in companies and organizations.
