## **Description**

The Master of Landscape Architecture program is devoted to the high-quality design of landscapes and urban spaces. The focus is on design work that combines aesthetic-artistic and scientific-technical methods. What does this degree program consist of?

The course focuses on the sustainable and viable design and development of new open spaces and landscapes. The design activity is central to this. It deals intensively with existing historical structures in public spaces. The Master of Landscape Architecture program imparts knowledge of building technology and plant use, ecology, the history of garden art and ideas, and urban planning theory and law.

The complex relationship between creative design and its economic, ecological and social context plays an important role. Design is always linked to the

technical and natural structures of its environment. It thus creates a link between artistic and scientific activity.

### **Quality and competences**

As a graduate, you will be responsible for the planning, design and development of open spaces and landscapes. Your specialist knowledge will enable you to develop comprehensive design solutions for complex landscape architecture problems. You will also be able to examine and implement these solutions in terms of their structural feasibility. In your work you will take account of social, historical and ecological contexts. In addition, you will have gained a broader understanding of natural and cultural science issues.
