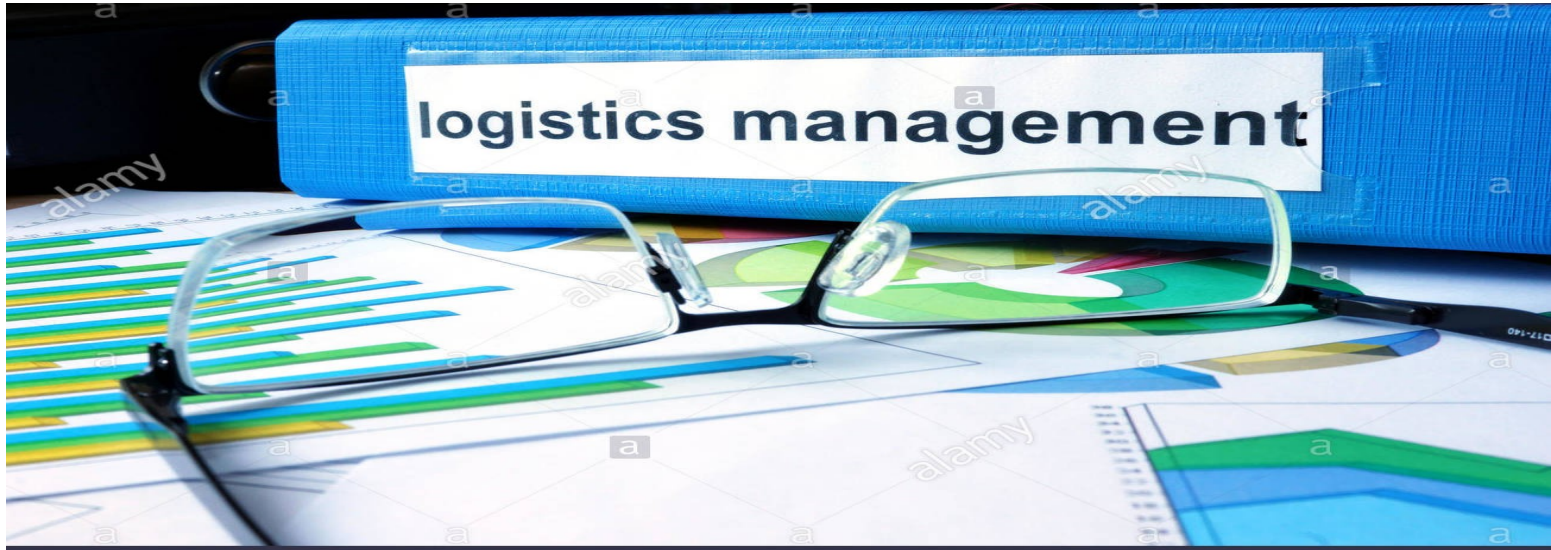

LOGISTICS CONSULTANT

As a logistics consultant, you develop future-oriented logistics concepts for your customers. The main objective is always to reduce stocks, shorten the transit time of goods and merchandise, and improve the preparation and delivery service. You can work in a large consultancy firm or in a highly specialized engineering or IT consultancy company.

SOURCING MANAGER/IN

A sourcing manager deals with the procurement of resources. The typical tasks of a sourcing manager are therefore to identify suitable suppliers, negotiate contracts and coordinate transport. The main objective is to obtain the highest value raw materials, goods or services at the best possible price. This requires continuous monitoring of market conditions and industry trends. Many also take on management roles in marketing or logistics.

PROCESS MANAGER

As a process manager, you execute processes based on numbers, data and facts. You have to identify the success factors and plan the process objectives. In addition, you ensure that the process documentation is up to date and you organize the training of new employees in your process. You will monitor compliance with the standard process, ensure that a uniform method of implementation is defined and intervene if the process threatens to get out of control. You will report the results to management
